MEASUREMENTS:

Sizes:			
40	45	50	cm
Finished measurement:			
44	50	56	cm
Length to back neck:			
20.5	23	25.5	cm
Sleeve length:			
10	12.5	15	cm

MATERIALS:

SHEPHERD GLEN MIST 8 PLY CREPE
50 g balls

Sweater:

3 3 3

V-Buttoning Cardigan:

3 3 3

Button to Neck Cardigan:

3 3 3

One pair each size 3.25 mm and 4 mm knitting needles. Set of four 3.25 mm double ended needles (or 3.25 mm circular needle) for Sweater. Stitch holders. 3 buttons for Sweater. 5 buttons for V-buttoning Cardigan. 7 buttons for Button to Neck Cardigan.

SWEATER

BACK:

****With 3.25 mm needles, cast on 49 (55: 61) sts and work in rib as fol:**

1st row: K1, *p1, k1, rep from * to end.

2nd row: P1, *k1, p1, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows 3 (4: 4) times more.

Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol:

1st row: (right side) K to end.

2nd row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

5th row: K3 (6: 1), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 6 (9: 4) sts, make knot, k to end.

6th row: As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

11th row: K7 (2: 5), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 10 (5: 8) sts, make knot, k to end.

12th row: P to end.

These 12 rows form the patt. Rep patt until Back meas 11.5 (13: 14) cm from beg (or length required), fin with a WS row.

Shape Raglans:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. [43 (49: 55) sts]

****Next row:** K2, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until 39 (41: 43) sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Divide for Back Opening:

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt 13 (14: 15) sts,

TENSION:

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm over stst on 4 mm needles.

NOTE: THIS PARAGRAPH IS MOST IMPORTANT.

To obtain perfect results, correct tension is absolutely essential. Check tension by knitting a sample at least 10 cm square. If you obtain more sts per 10 cm than specified change to larger needles, if less use smaller needles.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt = alternate; beg = begin(ning); cm = centimetres; dec = decrease(ing); fin = finishing; fol = follow(s)ing; gst = garter stitch (every row k); inc = increase(ing); k = knit; meas = measures; p = purl; patt = pattern; psso = pass slipped stitch over; rem = remain(ing); rep = repeat; RS = right side; sl = slip; st(s) = stitch(es); stst = stocking stitch (RS row k, WS row p); tog = together; WS = wrong side; yf = yarn forward.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

M1 = make 1 stitch (pick up horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st and work into back of it).

Make Knot = p3tog leaving sts on left hand needle, now knit them tog, then purl them tog again slipping sts off needle at end. **Note:** During shaping, do not work knot if this will interfere with shaping.

k5, **TURN** and cont on right side of neck only, leaving rem sts on a spare needle.

[21 (22: 23) sts]

Next row: K5, p to end.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Next row: K5, p to end.

Next row (buttonhole): K2, p2tog, patt to last 5 sts, k2, yf, k2tog, k1.

Next row: K5, p to end.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep last 2 rows twice more.

Next row: K5, p to end.

Next row (buttonhole): K2, p3tog, patt to last 5 sts, k2, yf, k2tog, k1.

Next row: K5, p to end.

Next row: K2, p3tog, patt to last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: K5, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more, thus fin with a WS row. Sl rem 9 (10: 11) sts onto a stitch holder for neckband.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts at neck edge and work as fol:

Next row: Cast on 5 sts, k across these 5 sts, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2. [21 (22: 23) sts]

Next row: P to last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: K5, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to last 5 sts, p5.

Rep last 2 rows until 15 (16: 17) sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K5, patt to last 5 sts, p3tog, k2.

Next row: P to last 5 sts, k5.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. Sl rem 9 (10: 11) sts onto a stitch holder for neckband.

FRONT:

Work as given for Back from ** to **.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until 27 (29: 31) sts rem, fin with a RS row.

Shape Neck:

Next row: P11, **TURN** and cont on right side of neck only, leaving rem sts on a spare needle.

Dec one st at raglan edge on next row and 2 sts on fol alt row and **AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge on next 3 rows.

P one row.

Next row: P3tog, k2.

Dec one st at neck edge only on fol alt row. Cast off.

Sl centre 5 (7: 9) sts onto a stitch holder for neckband.

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts at neck edge and p to end. [11 sts]

Dec one st at raglan edge on next row and 2 sts on fol alt row and **AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge on next 3 rows.

P one row.

Next row: K2, p3tog.

Dec one st at neck edge only on fol alt row. Cast off.

SLEEVES (2 Alike):

With 3.25 mm needles, cast on 29 (31: 33) sts and work 10 rows in rib as given for Back.

Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol:

1st row: (right side) K to end.

2nd row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

5th row: K1 (2: 3), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 4 (5: 6) sts, make knot, k1 (2: 3).

6th row: As 2nd row, inc one st each end of row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

11th row: K6 (7: 8), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 9 (10: 11) sts, make knot, k6 (7: 8).

12th row: As 2nd row, inc one st each end of row.

These 12 rows, omitting incs, form the patt. Rep patt and **AT THE SAME TIME**, working extra sts into patt, inc one st each end of every fol **5th** (8th: 8th) row until there are **35** (37: 41) sts.

Cont straight until Sleeve meas **10** (12.5: 15) cm from beg (or length required), fin with a WS row.

Shape Raglans:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. [**29** (31: 35) sts]

Sizes 45 (50) cm only:

Next row: K2, p1, patt to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

Next row: P to end.

All Sizes:

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until 7 sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K2, p3tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Sl rem 5 sts onto a stitch holder for Sweater and Button to Neck Cardigan. Cast off for V-Buttoning Cardigan.

NECKBAND:

Omitting ribbing, press all pieces according to instructions on bandwrap.

Join raglan seams.

With RS facing and set of four 3.25 mm double ended needles (or 3.25 mm circular needle), k9 (10: 11) sts from left back holder and 5 sts from left sleeve holder; pick up and k9 sts down left front neck; k5 (7: 9) sts from front neck holder; pick up and k9 sts up right front neck; k5 sts from right sleeve holder and 9 (10: 11) sts from right back holder. [**51** (55: 59) sts]

1st row: K5, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

2nd row (buttonhole): K6, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, k2, yf, k2tog, k1.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: K6, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, k5.

5th row: As 1st row.

Cast off knitwise over k sts and ribwise over rib sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sl st cast on sts of Back Opening to WS of work.

Press seams lightly.

Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

V-BUTTONING CARDIGAN

BACK:

Work as given for Sweater Back from ** to **.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until **25** (27: 29) sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K2, p3tog, patt to last 5 sts, p3tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. Cast off rem **13** (15: 17) sts.

LEFT FRONT:

(Worked first for Girl's Garment)

With 3.25 mm needles, cast on **27 (29: 33) sts and work in rib with gst border as fol:

1st row: *K1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, k5.

2nd row: K4, *p1, k1, rep from * to last st, p1.

Boy's Garment Only:

Rep these 2 rows once more.

Next row (buttonhole): *K1, p1, rep from * to last 5 sts, k1, k2tog, yf, k2.

Keeping gst border correct, work a further **3** (5: 5) rows in rib, inc one st at end of last row for size 45 cm only. [**27** (30: 33) sts]

Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol, working further buttonholes to match markers as before:

Girl's Garment Only:

Rep these 2 rows **3** (4: 4) times more, inc one st at end of last row for size 45 cm only. [**27** (30: 33) sts]

Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol:

Boy's and Girl's Garments:

1st row: (right side) K to end.

2nd row: K4, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

5th row: K3 (6: 1), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 8 sts, make knot, k to end.

6th row: As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

11th row: K7 (2: 5), *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

12th row: As 2nd row.

These 12 rows form the patt. Rep patt until Front meas same as Back to beg of raglan shaping, thus fin with a WS row.

Shape Raglan and Front Slope:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. [**24** (27: 30) sts]

Next row: K4, p to end.**

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 6 sts, k2tog, k4.

Next row: K4, p to end.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 5 sts, k5. Rep last 4 rows until 10 sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K2, p3tog, k to end.

Next row: K4, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Next row: K1, k2tog, k3.

Next row: K3, k2tog.

Work **11** (11: 13) rows in gst on rem 4 sts. Sl sts onto a safety pin.

Girl's Garment Only:

Mark button positions on band, the first in 5th row from cast on edge, the 5th one to come just below beg front slope shaping and the rem 3 spaced evenly between.

RIGHT FRONT:

(Worked first for Boy's Garment)

With 3.25 mm needles, cast on **27 (29: 33) sts and work in rib with gst border as fol:

1st row: K5, *p1, k1, rep from * to end.

2nd row: *P1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, p1, k4.

Girl's Garment Only:

Rep these 2 rows once more.

Next row (buttonhole): K1, k2tog, yf, k2, *p1, k1, rep from * to end.

Keeping gst border correct, work a further **3** (5: 5) rows in rib, inc one st at beg of last row for size 45 cm only. [**27** (30: 33) sts] Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol, working further buttonholes to match markers as before:

Boy's Garment Only:

Rep these 2 rows **3** (4: 4) times more, inc one st at beg of last row for size 45 cm only. [**27** (30: 33) sts]

Change to 4 mm needles and work in patt as fol:

Boy's and Girl's Garments:

1st row: (right side) K to end.

2nd row: P to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

5th row: K5, *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 6 (9: 4) sts, make knot, k to end.

6th row: As 2nd row.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

11th row: K9, *make knot, k5, rep from * to last 10 (5: 8) sts, make knot, k to end.

12th row: As 2nd row.

These 12 rows form the patt. Rep patt until Front meas same as Back to beg of raglan shaping, thus fin with a WS row.

Work one more row.

Shape Raglan and Front Slope:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. [**24** (27: 30) sts]

****Next row:** K4, sl 1, k1, psso, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to last 4 sts, k4.

Next row: K5, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2. Rep last 4 rows until 10 sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K to last 5 sts, p3tog, k2.

Next row: P to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

Next row: K3, sl 1, k1, psso, k1.

Next row: K2tog, k3.

Work **11** (11: 13) rows in gst on rem 4 sts. Sl sts onto a safety pin.

Boy's Garment Only:

Mark button positions on band, the first one in 5th row from cast on edge, the 5th one to come just below beg front slope shaping and the rem 3 spaced evenly between.

SLEEVES:

Work as given for Sweater Sleeves.

TO MAKE UP:

Omitting ribbing, press all pieces according to instructions on bandwrap.

Join raglan, side and sleeve seams.

Join ends of neckband tog and sew in place across back neck.

Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

Press seams lightly.

BUTTON TO NECK CARDIGAN BACK:

Work as given for Sweater Back from ** to **.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows until **25 (27: 29)** sts rem, fin with a WS row.

Next row: K2, p3tog, patt to last 5 sts, p3tog, k2.

Next row: P to end.

Rep last 2 rows twice more. Sl rem **13 (15: 17)** sts onto a stitch holder for neckband.

LEFT FRONT:

Work as given for V-Buttoning Cardigan Left Front from ** to **.

Next row: K2, p2tog, patt to last 5 sts, k5.

Next row: K4, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows until **16 (17: 18)** sts rem, fin with a RS row.

Shape Neck:

Next row: K4, p1 (2: 3), sl these sts onto a safety pin for neckband, patt to end. [11 sts]

Dec one st at raglan edge on next row and 2 sts on fol alt row and **AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge on next 3 rows.

P one row.

Next row: K2, p3tog.

Dec one st at neck edge only on fol alt row. Cast off.

Girl's Garment Only:

Mark button positions on band, the first one in 5th row from cast on edge, allowing for the 7th one to come in centre of neckband and the rem 5 spaced evenly between.

RIGHT FRONT:

Work as given for V-Buttoning Cardigan Right Front from ** to **.

Next row: K5, patt to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2.

Next row: P to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep last 2 rows until **16 (17: 18)** sts rem, fin with a RS row.

Shape Neck:

Next row: P to last 5 (6: 7) sts, **TURN** and sl these sts onto a safety pin for neckband. [11 sts]

Dec one st at raglan edge on next row and 2 sts on fol alt row and **AT THE SAME TIME** dec one st at neck edge on next 3 rows.

P one row.

Next row: P3tog, k2.

Dec one st at neck edge only on fol alt row. Cast off.

Boy's Garment Only:

Mark button positions on band, the first one in 5th row from cast on edge, allowing for the 7th one to come in centre of neckband and the rem 5 spaced evenly between.

SLEEVES:

Work as given for Sweater Sleeves.

NECKBAND:

Omitting ribbing, press all pieces according to instructions on bandwrap.

Join raglan seams.

With RS facing and 3.25 mm needles, k5 (6: 7) sts from safety pin at right front; pick up and k9 sts up right front neck; k5 sts from right sleeve holder, **13 (15: 17)** sts from back neck holder and 5 sts from left sleeve holder; pick up and k9 sts down left front neck; k5 (6: 7) sts from safety pin at left front. [**51 (55: 59)** sts]

Next row: K4, *p1, k1, rep from * to last 5 sts, p1, k4.

Keeping 4 sts each end of row in gst, work 4 more rows in rib, working a further buttonhole as before on next row.

Cast off knitwise over k sts and ribwise over rib sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

Press seams lightly.
